AN ADDITIONAL DEFECT NOTICE MAY BE ISSUED IF FAULTS ARE DETECTED DURING EXAMINATION.

THE REGISTRATION OF THIS VEHICLE MAY NOT BE RENEWED IF CLEARANCE OF THIS DEFECT IS NOT OBTAINED.

Light vehicle defect – The driver of a vehicle who is given a defect notice must cause the defect notice to be sent to the registered operator of the vehicle.

Heavy vehicle defect – If the driver of a heavy vehicle for which a vehicle defect notice is issued is not the operator of the vehicle, the driver must, as soon as practicable, give the notice to the operator. If the notice is not cleared by the Regulator under section 530 of the Heavy Vehicle National Law, the vehicle's registration may be suspended and subsequently cancelled under this law.

Heavy vehicle self-clearing defect: If the driver of the vehicle is not the operator of the vehicle, the driver must give the notice to the operator as soon as practicable, but not more than 14 days, after the notice is issued.
